Bequests to Parishes: The Archdiocese of Toronto was incorporated in 1845 by an Act of Parliament as a corporation sole, a legal entity consisting of a single ("sole") incorporated office. As a consequence, individual parishes do not exist as separate legal entities but as constituted parts of the archdiocese. Thus, Releases and other legally binding estate documents can only be signed by an individual with the authority to bind the archdiocese. These individuals include: the Archbishop of Toronto, both Chancellors, and the Controller. Due to the corporate structure of the archdiocese, a pastor does not have the authority to sign legally binding estate-related documents for a parish under his care.

Whenever your parish becomes the beneficiary of a bequest, it always gets 100% of its entitlement, however the Development Office administers the process of implementing the binding/signing authority principle. Please forward any estate documents received by your parish to the Development Office either by mail to: 1155 Yonge Street, Toronto, ON M4T 1W2 or by email to development@archtoronto.org.

Pre-Authorized Giving Plan - Many parishes in our Diocese are offering this plan as a convenience for their parishioners. We are offering it at the request of several of our parishioners. Some find it easier to support their church by having their donation automatically withdrawn from their bank account on the 20th of each month. This also ensures the ongoing support of our church when they are away. Many find this method more convenient as many of us are accustomed to paying our utilities in this manner. You will still have the option of placing your envelopes in the collection basket, especially for special collections. If you are interested in giving in this way there are brochures at the back of the church. To enroll, you must submit the form, in the brochure with your void cheque, before the 10th of the first month in order for your deduction to begin on the 20th of the same month.

Baptisms: A family requesting a baptism is expected to be attending Mass on a regular basis in one of our churches. Please speak to Fr. John after Mass to discuss the Sacrament.
